ENGLISH UNCOMMON WORDS



EXPOUND /ik'spaund/

Meaning : v. Add details or explanation; clarify the meaning; state in depth.

Bahasa Indonesia : Menguraikan/menjelaskan secara rinci.

Synonym : explain, elucidate, interpret

Sentence Example:

- The CEO refused to expound on the decision to merge our department with another one.
- The government has printed a paper expounding the advantages of the plan to the people.

PAUCITY /'pɔ:səti/


Meaning : n. the presence of something in only small or insufficient quantities or amounts.

Bahasa Indonesia : Jumlah yang sedikit; kekurangan

Synonym : insufficiency, inadequacy, scantiness

Sentence Example :

- The paucity of fruits and vegetables was caused by the drought.
- However, there is a paucity of research on the plantation issue.



SNUGGLE /'snʌg(ə)l/

Meaning : v. settle or move into a warm, comfortable position.

Bahasa Indonesia : Duduk atau berbaring, atau mendekat dengan rapat-rapat.

Synonym : curl up, nestle, huddle


Sentence Example:

- When I read aloud, my goal is to snuggle around the warm glow of a story.
- Baby can snuggle up to the singing, breathing, synthetic bear.
